In follow-up to the Teladoc e-mail recently sent, we want to inform you that Aetna International has offered an enhanced telemedicine service. This service, vHealth, is very similar to Teladoc but will be available **at no cost to you for the next 90 days through June 15, 2020**. In addition, unlike Teladoc which is only available in the U.S., **you can access vHealth from anywhere in the world**. vHealth offers services similar to Teladoc, including issuing prescriptions for certain medical conditions. Below is additional information on your vHealth service.

## vHealth Services Description

- vHealth allows CPChem Expat Medical Plan employees and dependents (members) to speak to an experienced doctor by telephone or video call, without travelling to a medical facility or worrying about infection.
- Whether you want to talk about COVID-19 or any other medical concern, you can use the service 24/7, from any country in the world.
- All consultations are completely confidential, unlimited and available in multiple languages.

## 3 easy ways to book a vHealth consultation

- The vHealth by Aetna app
  - Download the vHealth app from the <u>App store</u> or <u>Google Play</u>
  - Register your details and enter the access code VHEALTH90
  - Book an appointment by following the onscreen instructions
